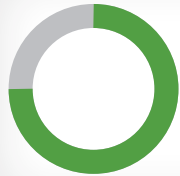
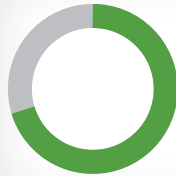

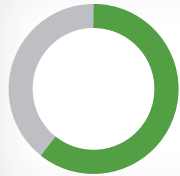

Celebrating our 75th year, we help **30,000+ adults and children** annually through substance use recovery, primary care, affordable housing, and emergency, inpatient, outpatient, and school-based mental health services.

Mariposa Women's Hospital, Florida's first women's behavioral health hospital, will open in 2025, enabling us to serve even more loved ones in need of mental health services and **specifically meeting the needs of women.**
